

Persons willing to enter the festival grounds must be at least 18 years or older, review these regulations and accept and comply with the provisions.

Entry to the festival

Every person who wishes to enter the festival must be in possession of either a valid entry ticket or a special admission issued by the organiser of the festival. Forging the entry ticket or admission is strictly forbidden and will be prosecuted without exception. Entry tickets are non-refundable and non-transferable. In case you are unable to go, we advise to sell your ticket on Ticketswap (at own risk) since this is currently the safest way to resell your tickets.

Access to the festival grounds can be denied or refused to people by the festival security. This will most likely happen in cases such as:

- Being visibly under the influence of any mind altering substance.
- Disturbing behaviour such as assault, hatred etc.
- Being in violation with any of the provisions of these internal regulations.

Every person trying to enter the festival may be searched by the security. Failure to comply or bringing items that can be used to harm others may result in access denial.

In case you need to bring anything to the festival that may not comply with the above, such as medication, we ask you to bring legal papers stating you are allowed to bring said thing.

Being at the festival

On the festival grounds, it is strictly forbidden to do the following:

- Try to access inaccessible areas such as production rooms, back-stage, on-stage etc. unless your admission permits you to access the certain area.
- Climb obstructions such as fences, lighting columns or any infrastructure on site.

- Obstruct the accesses, exits and evacuation routes or to linger at these locations any longer than necessary for entering or exiting the site.
- Sell anything to other visitors of the festival.

Texts, symbols, images, gestures and obscene language inciting racism, xenophobia, provocation and discrimination are strictly forbidden.

People at the festival agree to follow any instructions imposed by the organiser in the framework of the public peace and safety during the event.

Organizers rights

For safety reasons, the organizer reserves the right to:

- Interrupt or stop the festival at any given time.
- Provisionally keep the visitors on site at the end of the festival.
- Totally or partially vacate the site.
- Deny access to the site regardless of the possession of a valid entry ticket.
- Postpone the festival to a different date (tickets will still be valid on the new date but will not be refundable).

The organizer also has the right to photograph or film every person who enters the festival. These photos and/or videos may be used to promote any festival hosted by the organization.
